**Did you know?**

The term spirit is Middle English with its roots in Anglo-French or Latin; it stems from the Anglo-French term esprit, spirit; and from the Latin word spiritus, which literally means breath; from the term spirare, meaning to blow, breathe.

The term spirits is typically given to those distilled beverages which are low in sugars and which contain a minimum of thirty five per cent alcohol by volume. Some of the common types of spirits include Gin, vodka and rum.

**Did you know?**

The first marketed soft drinks (non-carbonated) in the Western world appeared in the 17th century. They were made from water and lemon juice sweetened with honey. In 1676, the Compagnie des Limonadiers of Paris was granted a monopoly for the sale of lemonade soft drinks. Vendors carried tanks of lemonade on their backs and dispensed cups of the soft drink to thirsty Parisians.

- 1. **Urmeneta Sauvignon Blanc, Chile** .....£14.00  
Fresh in style with a blend of herbal notes and tropical fruits.
- 2. **Urmeneta Merlot, Chile** .....£14.00  
Medium bodied with blackberry and plum aromas and soft tannins.

**\* WHITE WINE \***

- 3. **Pinot Grigio, Santepietra, Italy** .....£16.50  
Delightfully light and refreshing white with flavours of peach and pear.
- 4. **Goldridge Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand** ..... £17.95  
Bold flavours of lemon, lime, grapefruit and gooseberry tantalise the palate and provide a refreshing clean finish.
- 5. **Peter Lehmann 'Weighbridge' Unoaked Chardonnay** ..... £17.50  
Vibrant but smooth flavours of peach and citrus in a well rounded and easy drinking style.
- 6. **Montes Classic Reserve Chardonnay, Chile** ..... £17.50  
Pleasant citrus and banana followed by lightly oaked exotic fruit.
- 7. **Petit Chablis Pas Si Petit, France** ..... £22.50  
A distinctively dry, crisp wine, full of flavour and finesse.

**\* RED WINE \***

- 8. **Argento Malbec, Argentina** ..... £17.95  
Flavours of ripe blackberries and blackcurrants lead to a long finish dominated by soft, sweet tannins.
- 9. **Villa Montes Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile**..... £17.50  
Light, easy drinking, smooth red with lots of munchy blackcurrant fruit.
- 10. **Chianti DOCG Serristori, Italy** ..... £19.50  
Attractive cherry and raspberry aromas on the nose & a smooth distinctive palate.
- 11. **Peter Lehmann Shiraz, Australia** .....£19.50  
A beautifully structured wine with a rich softly-fruited palate, superbly integrated oak and a firm finish.
- 12. **Faustino VII Tinto, Rioja, Spain** .....£19.50  
Well balanced, velvety, elegant wine with a powerful lingering aroma and vanilla tones of oak.
- 13. **La Chasse Du Pape Rouge, France** ..... £19.50  
A medium bodied, smooth red, full of ripe fruit and a hint of spice.
- 14. **Sangre De Toro, Spain**..... £21.50  
A sensual background of fine spice with perfumed notes reminiscent of blackcurrants and a full long finish on the palate.

**\* PREMIUM WINE \***

- 15. **Villa Maria Private Bin Merlot Cabernet, New Zealand**..... £21.95  
Hints of cassis and subtle oak on the nose while the palate shows berry fruit and spice and a soft lingering finish.
- 16. **Villa Maria Clifford Bay Sauvignon Blanc Reserve, New Zealand** . £24.95  
An intense explosion of passionfruit, melon and ripe peach. Tropical fruit flavours fill the palate, which is rich, pure, luscious and long.

**Did you know?**

Although the average life span of a grapevine is 25 years, grapevines are actually capable of producing grapes for more than 100 years.

**Did you know?**

The pressure in a bottle of champagne is 90 pounds per square inch, about three times that in an automobile tire.

The longest champagne cork flight in the world was 177 feet, 9 inches, set by American Heinrich Medicus in New York in 1988.

A champagne cork leaves the bottle at a velocity of approximately 38-40 mph, but can pop out at as fast as 100 mph.

**A glass of wine (about 4 oz.) contains about 85 calories.**

**One acre of grapevines equals about 800 gallons of wine..**

**Did you know?**

Beer was not sold in bottles until 1850; it was not sold in cans until 1935

Bursting with strawberry, pomegranate and watermelon flavours with a lingering finish of orange peel and spice.

- 19. **Freixenet Cordon Negro Cava** .....£19.95  
Light, long and elegant with a refreshing palate, the sparkle balancing the green and citrus fruits.
- 20. **Freixenet Cordon Rosado Cava (Rose)** ..... £19.95  
Rich floral and fresh bay leaf aromas blending with ripe red fruits, blackberry and strawberry.

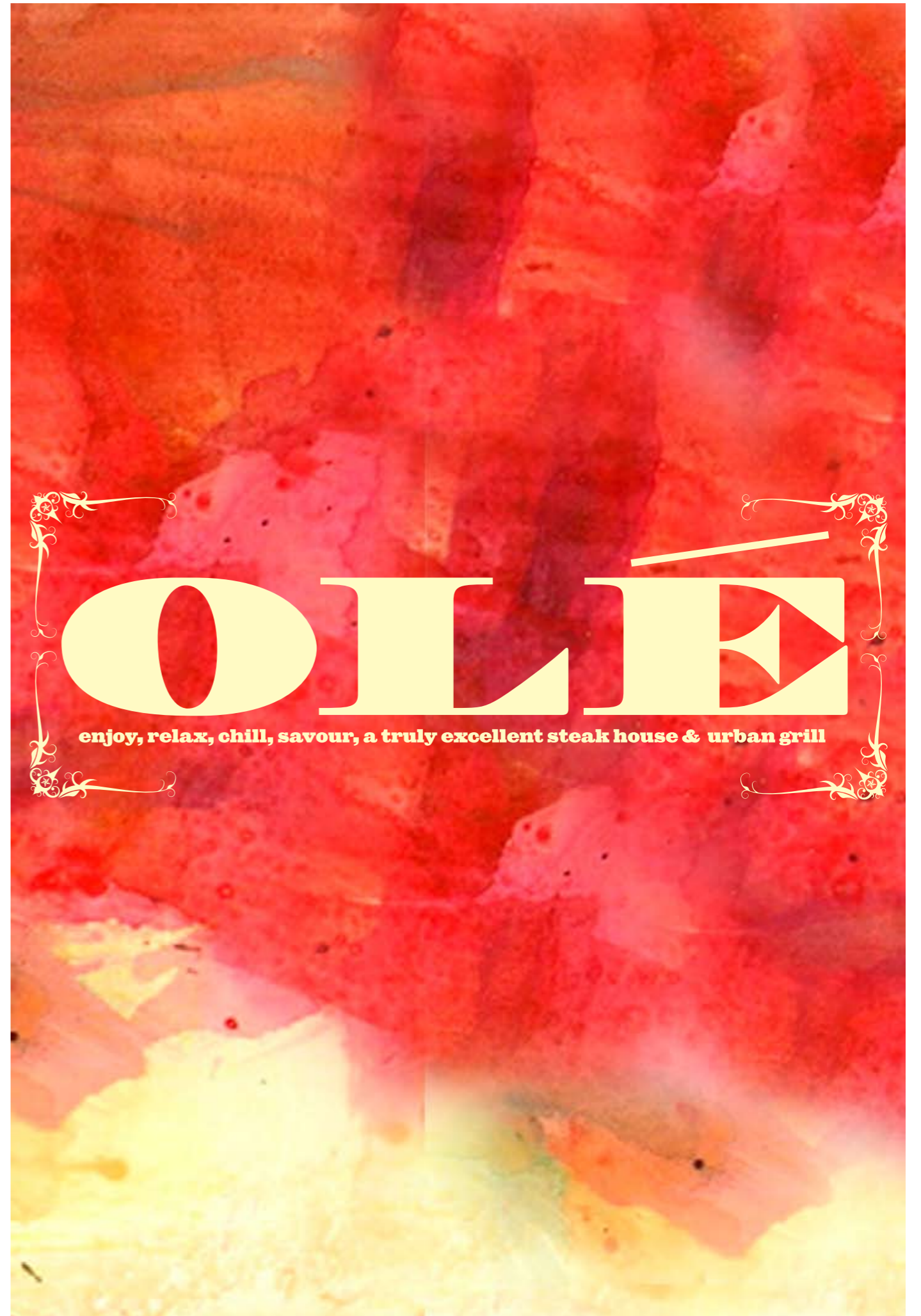
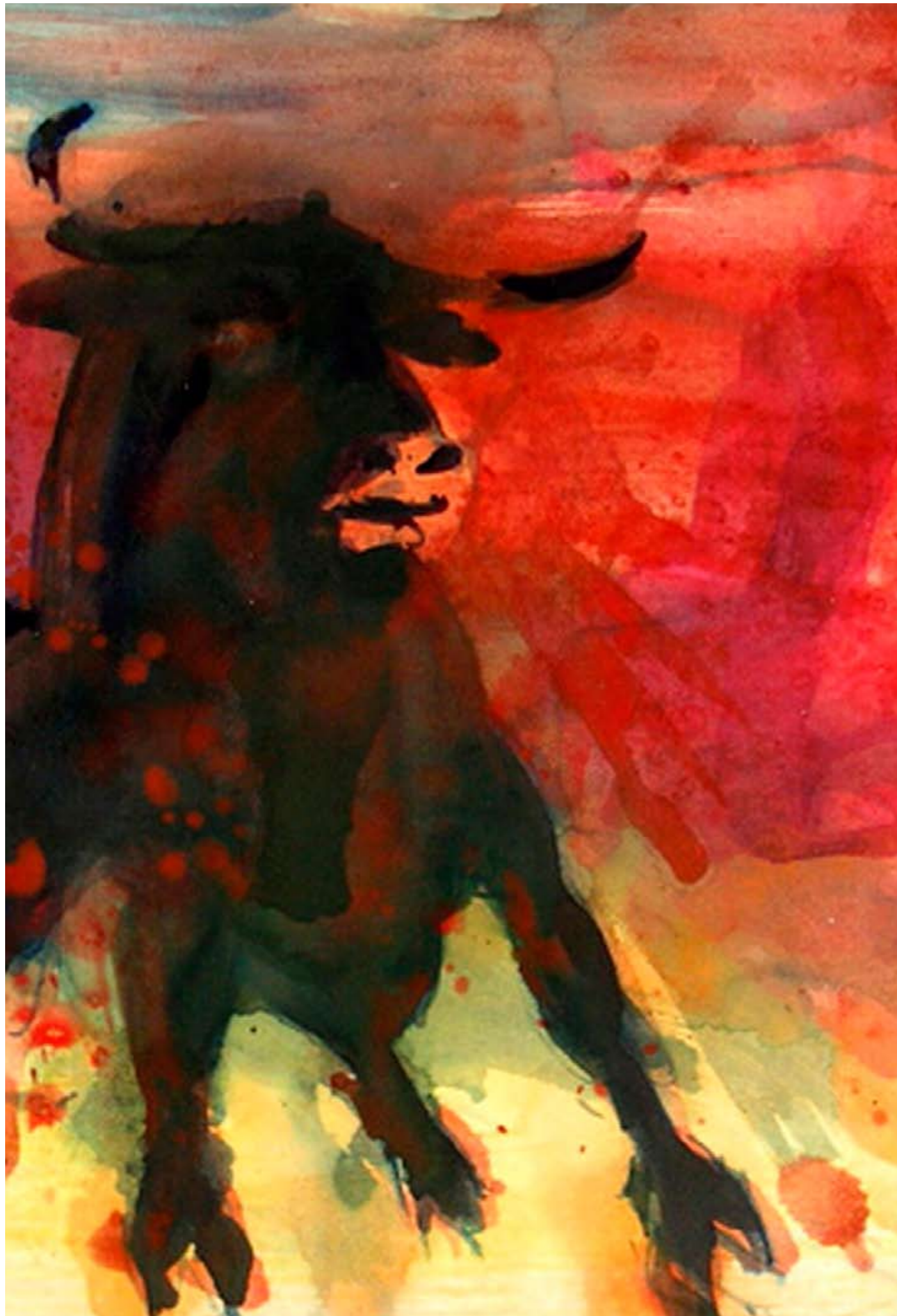
- 21. **Piper Heidsieck Brut** .....£46.50  
Biscuity, balanced champagne from one of the top houses. Complex & yeasty with a soft mousse & warm ripe flavours.
- 22. **Piper Sauvage Rose** ..... £47.50  
Lively generous and intense with a freshness expressed by the slight tartness of red fruit which then mellows with the aromas of macerated fruit and red plums.
